

Section 9. Eligible Training Provider List

The workforce development system established under the WIOA emphasizes informed consumer choice, job-driven training, provider performance, and continuous improvement. The quality and selection of training providers and programs of training services is vital to achieving these core principles.

The State of Wyoming's **Eligible Training Provider List** (ETPL) and related eligibility procedures ensure the accountability, quality, and labor market relevance of programs of training services that receive funds through WIOA programs. This list can serve as an important tool for participants and case managers in identifying training in high demand industries that result in positive outcomes and recognized credentials. Wyoming's ETPL can be accessed through the www.wyomingatwork.com MIS.

It is **required** for Adult and Dislocated Worker participants, and preferred for youth participants, that **Occupational Skills Training** be provided by providers determined eligible to receive funds through WIOA. Eligibility is determined following submission of an ETPL application to the Wyoming Workforce Development Council (WWDC), and provider performance is reviewed every year.
