

# Workforce Development Training Fund

## Grant Information and Highlights

### Business Training Grants

The Business Training Grant provides up to \$4,000 per trainee, per state fiscal year (SFY). Preferred industries can receive up to \$5,000 per trainee, per SFY.

A business entity is eligible to apply for up to \$200,000 per SFY.

### Internship Grants

The Internship Grant funds up to 520 hours (up to \$25/hr), supported by labor market industry averages.

Businesses can host up to 6 internships per SFY, based on demonstrated need, and the ability to offer quality work experience for each intern.

### Pre-Hire Economic Development Grants

Pre-Hire Economic Development Grant changes make emergency medical service providers eligible to participate in Pre-Hire Economic Development Grants.

The Pre-Hire grant will continue to provide funding to obtain trained workers for a new or expanding business, in addition to now providing training funds to replace lost workers.

### Apprenticeship Grants

The Apprenticeship Grant is available to Wyoming-based Registered Apprenticeship Programs and its related technical instruction providers to assist with the cost of the related instruction of the registered apprenticeship program.
